### **Ten Commandments for Kairos Cookies**

1. Thou shalt not bake fragile cookies that will turn to crumbs before eaten.
2. Thou shalt not bake cookies greater than 3inch-es in diameter.
3. Thou shalt not put icing or sugar on top of cookies.
4. Thou shalt not put raisins or other fruits in or on cookies.
5. Thou shalt not bake notes or trinkets inside cookies.
6. Thou shalt not cheat and send store-bought cookies; we know how to tell and these will be thrown away! These will NOT be allowed in.
7. Thou shalt not use bags that fall open when handled or use twist ties, boxes or tins of any kind.
8. Thou shalt bake cookies such as chocolate chip, peanut butter, marshmallow treats (Rice Krispies), oatmeal or any not covered in the "shalt not's".
9. Thou shalt pack fully cooled cookies in plastic zip-lock bags. Label bag with type of cookie.
10. Thou shalt put only one dozen cookies in each bag.

**Thou should pray over the cookies while they are "maturing" in the oven; that the Holy Spirit will touch the hearts of those who partake.**
